

Congregate Meal Participants

Beginning Monday, January 21, 2019, the VNA (Volunteer Network on Aging) will be unable to serve our daily Congregate Meals to Bluebell Towers due to construction being done in the Kitchen at the Facility. We want to help in any way possible during this time to ensure that all individuals have their nutrition needs met. If you are interested in receiving our Home Delivered Meals on a **TEMPORARY BASIS** during the construction, please contact Megan at the VNA (309) 342-1152 or toll free at 1 (877) 556-1464. Our Home Delivered Meals Program consists of cold meals, delivered once every other week via FED EX, that you refrigerate and heat up daily as needed.

The VNA is also looking into a temporary congregate site elsewhere in Abingdon, and we will let residents know **IF/WHEN** that becomes available. In addition, we want to let you know that the United Methodist Church in Abingdon has a food pantry distribution on Tuesdays from 12-3, that may be utilized once per month. Also, there is a food program called Cupboard & Closet which is held at the Abingdon Community Center every Friday from 4:30-5:30. You are to enter from the Assemblies of God parking lot, pull around back and look for signs that will direct you to the pick up location.

Someone from the VNA will come to Bluebell Towers this Friday, January 18 from 11am-12pm to answer questions and give you any plan updates. However, if you are interested in more information about the Home Delivered Meals, please call Megan as soon as possible so we can get that process started.
